### **International Diploma Program (IDP)**

#### **QUICK FACTS 2009 - 2010**

**History:** Our program was established in 1994. We are in our 15<sup>th</sup> year.

**Accreditation:** We have dual accreditation

1. We are accredited by the Thai Ministry of Education. Our Thai High School Diploma is accepted in Thailand (both public and private universities) and overseas.
2. We are a department of St. John's International School. As such, we are accredited by World Wide Educational Services (WES), a prestigious accreditation organization based in Britain.

**Grades Offered:** Grades 10-12 (Years 11-13)

**Academic Calendar:** The 2009-2010 academic year will start on August 20 and end on June 25. We follow a three term academic system.

**Curriculum:** North American curriculum with Science or Business/Humanities electives in grades 11 and 12. All subjects are taught in English except Thai language.

**Intensive ESL:** We offer an intensive ESL program for students whose English skills are not adequate for the mainstream classes.

**Graduates:** Almost all of our graduates go on to study in university. Countries where our graduates are studying include Australia, Canada, England, Germany, Thailand and USA.

**Tuition Fees:** For the 2009-2010 academic year, our fees are **403,500** Baht for Grade 10 students and **411,000** Baht for Grade 11 and 12

students. The fee includes a morning snack and buffet lunch. The fees are payable in three equal installments the first day of each term.

**Other costs:**

- 50,000 Baht non-refundable deposit (Grade 11 new students).
- 5,000 Baht per year for textbook rental.
- Students are required to buy the school uniform. Cost would depend on the number of sets a student requires. There is also a sports uniform.
- Students are required to have one set of sports shoes that are worn only in our Sports Hall (Gymnasium).
- Art students may be required to buy some special art materials from time to time, depending on the projects they undertake.

**Admission Requirements:**

Students of all nationalities are welcome to apply provided they meet our academic requirements:

Grade 10\*            Pass our English placement test with 50%  
                         Pass our math placement test with 50%

Grade 11/12\*       Pass our English placement test with 60%  
                         Pass our math placement test with 60%

\*If applicants fail to meet the minimum entrance requirements, they will be asked to attend remedial courses.
